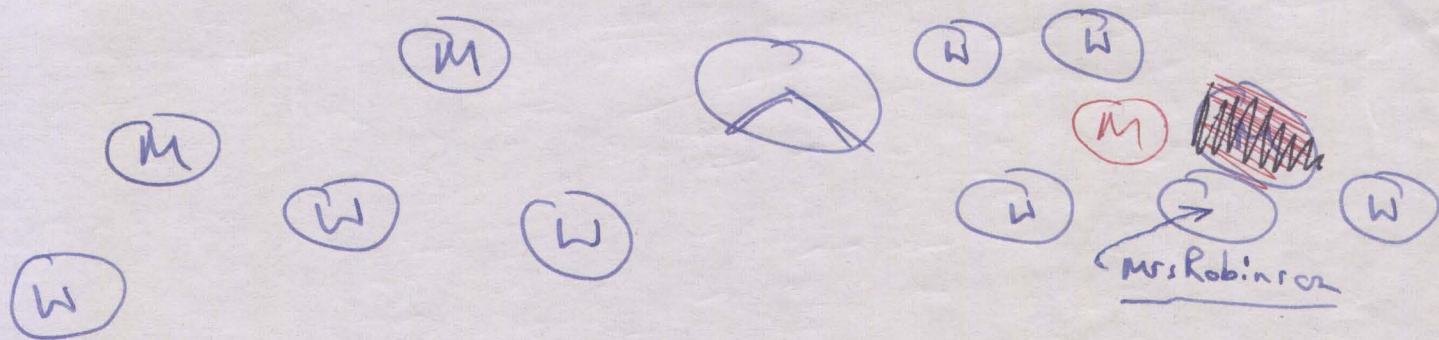

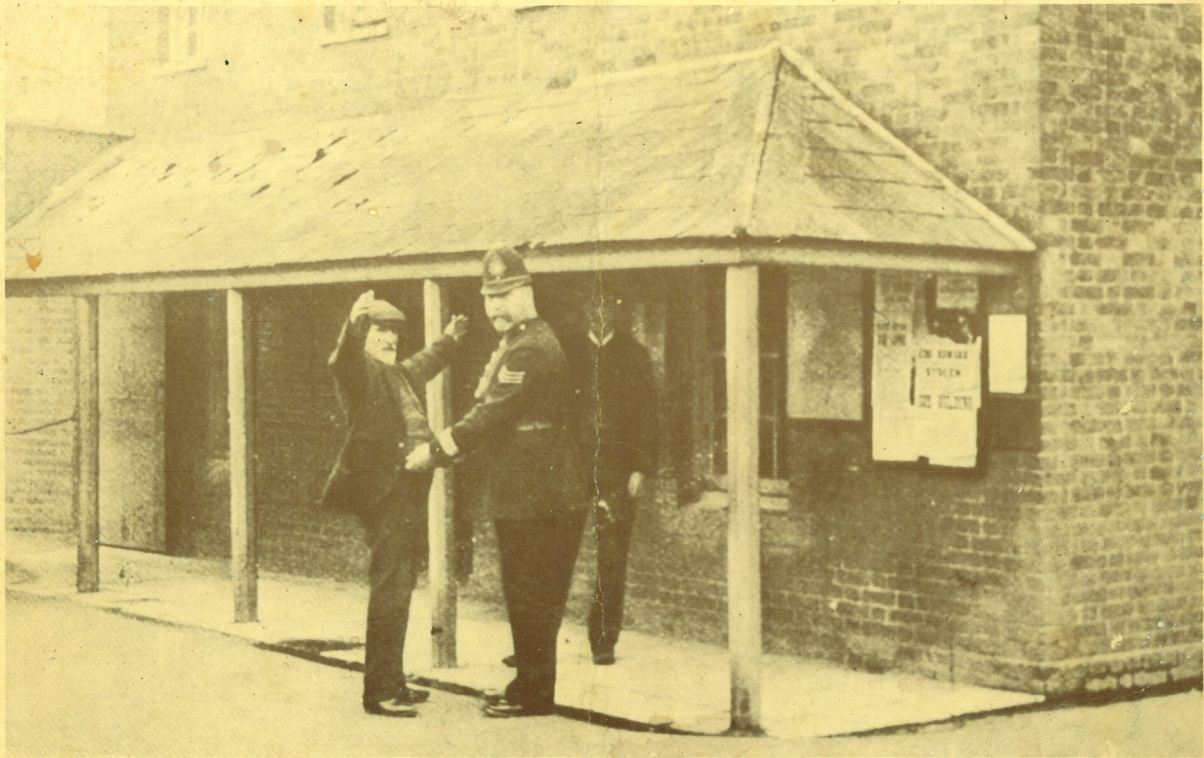

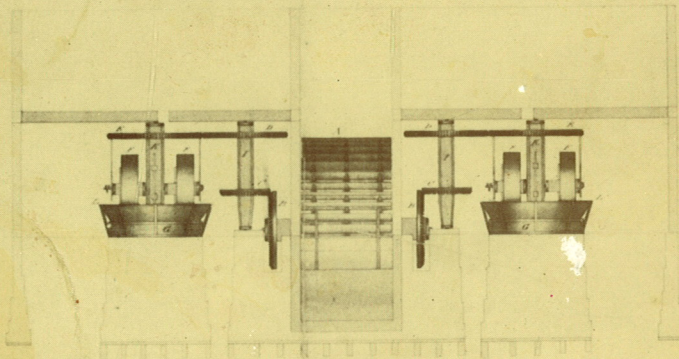

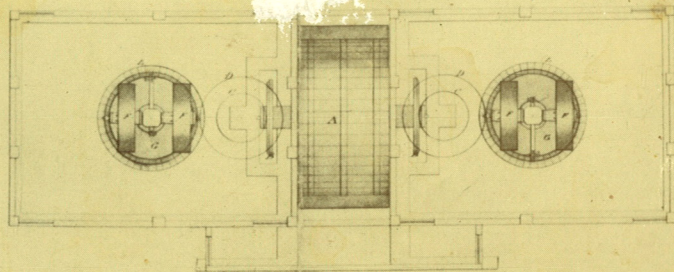

Ground Plan.

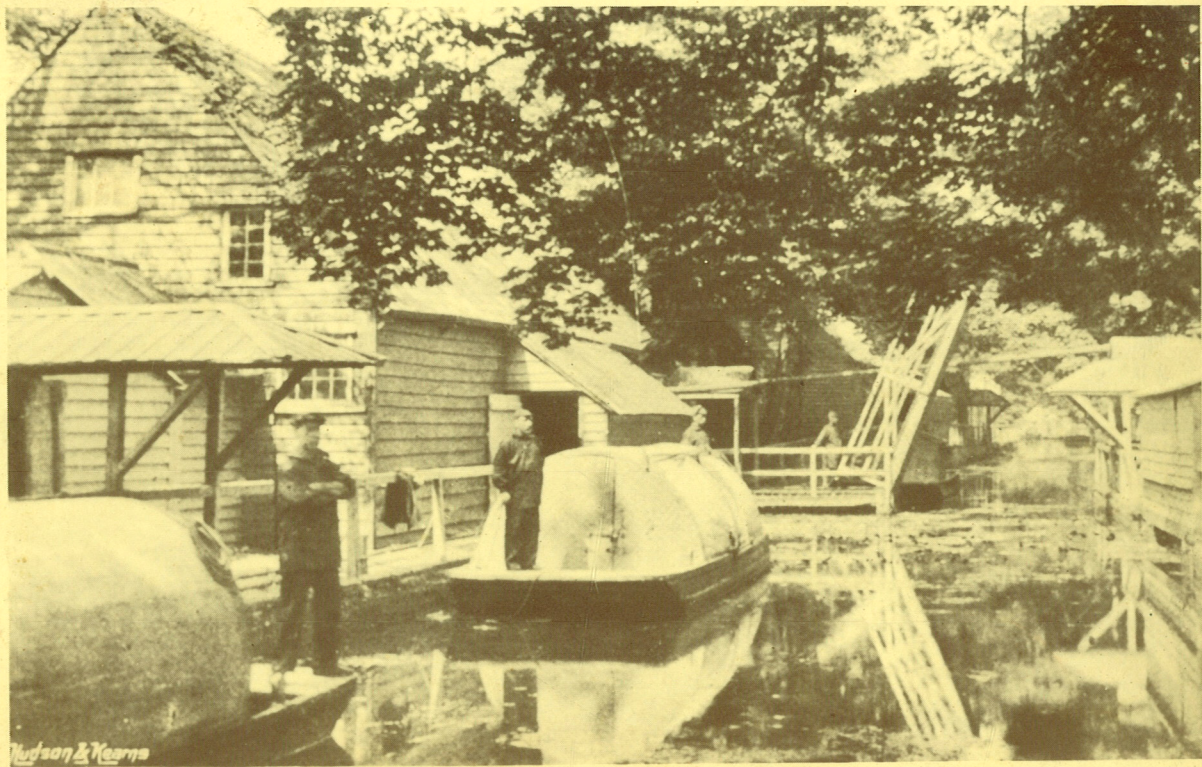
